

Jason Dean Hunt Memorial SCHOLARSHIP

The Greyhound Hall of Fame will award a \$1,000 scholarship, the Jason Dean Hunt Memorial, each spring. The purpose of the scholarships is to encourage post high school education to students connected with the sport of Greyhound racing.

The Scholarship winner will be announced at the National Greyhound Association Spring Meet. The scholarship recipient will receive \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester. The students must be in good

standing and provide a transcript of the fall semester to receive the second payment.

The recipients will be selected by a panel of independent judges based solely on the application forms and the three recommendations.

The scholarship was named after U.S. Army Spc. Jason Dean Hunt, a son of Gale Hunt and grandson of Kay Smith, who was killed in a shooting at Ft. Hood, TX in 2009.
